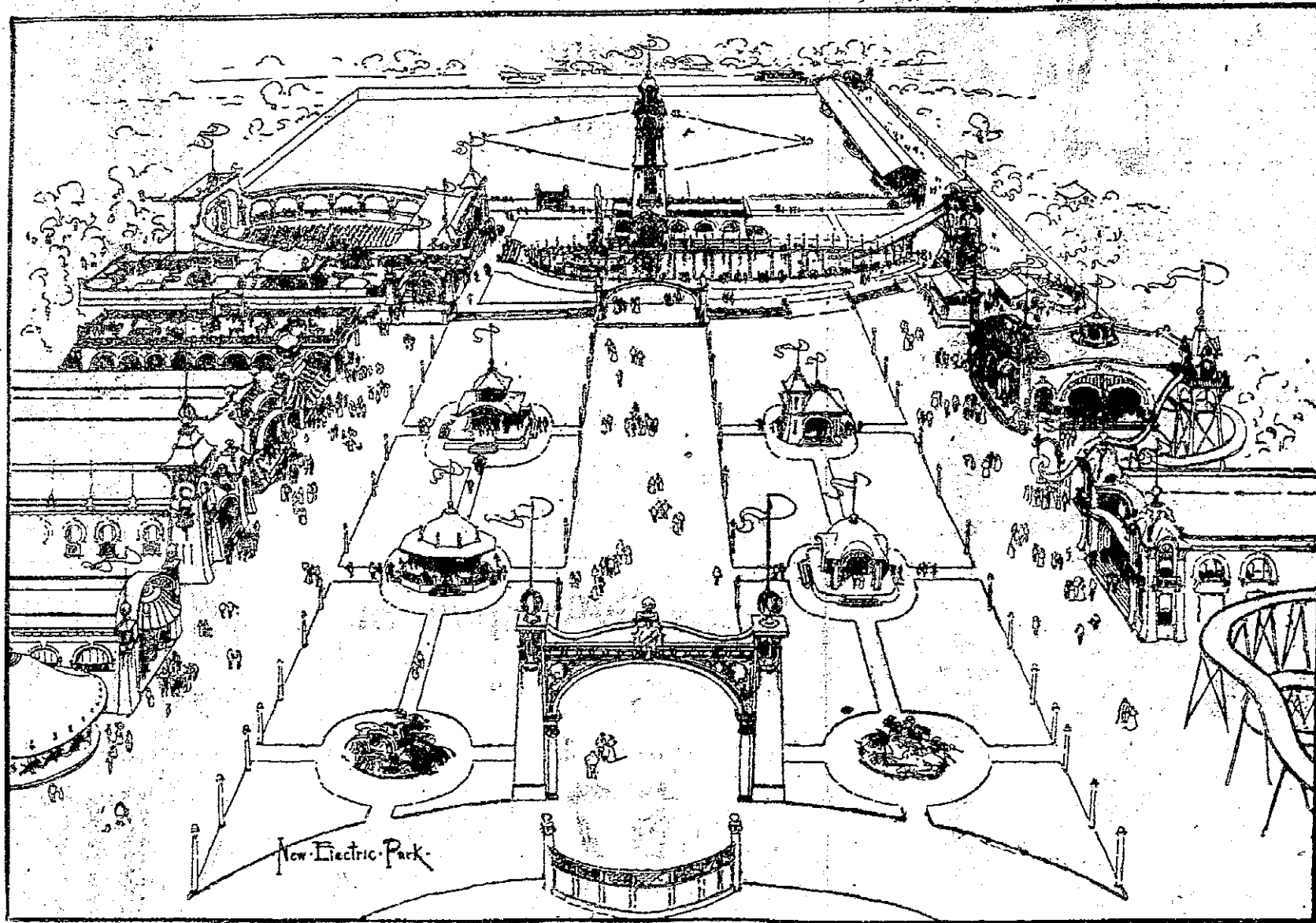

The Cuban government has at last seen fit to pardon the American girl and the two American men who committed the awful crime of erecting a trolley telegraph line in Nueva Gerona, Isle of Pines. The girl is pretty 19-year-old Millie Brown and the men are H. C. Augustine and L. C. Giltner. Miss Brown's parents keep a boarding house and Giltner, who keeps a general store in the town, boards there. He and Miss Brown are engaged. Giltner understands telegraphy and has taught something of it to his sweetheart. One day he decided it would be a good idea to rig up a telegraph line between the store and the house so that he could quickly communicate sweet nothings to Miss Brown as they occurred to him. The line, which was only 1800 feet long, ran by way of Augustine's house, and that's where he got in. Now it seems that in 1902, when general Wood was governor general of Cuba, he issued a military order forbidding the erection of telegraph or telephone lines without proper authorization. ### MEAT.

**Mince-meat.**  
One quart bowl chopped meat, 2 quart bowl chopped apples, 3 pounds seeded raisins, 3 pounds currants, 1 pound citron cut fine, 2 large nutmegs, 3 even tablespoons ground cinnamon, 4 even teaspoons ground cloves, 1 pint of preserved orange peel cut fine, 1 pint of preserved lemon peel cut fine, 1 pint of best molasses, 1 quart of brown sugar, salt to taste.  
Put 4 quarts of hard cider in preserving kettle, then add the fruit and orange and lemon peel and let stand over night. Then add the rest of the ingredients and cook until the raisins are tender. If not moist enough add more hard cider and a quart best brandy and 1 pound butter.  
**Fish Chowder.**  
Take 4 pounds fresh fish, cleaned and cut in pieces 3 inches square, place in kettle 5 slices salt pork, then add three onions sliced thin, fry them brown, then put in a layer of fish, sprinkle with pepper and salt, then a layer of peeled sliced potatoes, then fish and potatoes till fish is used up; cover with water and let boil half an hour. Roll 6 crackers, put in with the fish and lastly add a quart of hot milk. Let it get thoroughly heated and serve.
